### New Study Analyzes the Impact of Housing Development on School Enrollment in Four New Hampshire Communities

New Hampshire Housing and Urbanomics recently published a report that analyzes the impacts that housing development had on school enrollment in four communities across New Hampshire. The study, which examined trends from 2014 to 2023, had several key findings, including that new construction during this period produced 0.16 public school students per unit statewide and resulted in a net fiscal benefit for some local school districts. These findings suggest that new housing development did not significantly increase school enrollment in these areas and that new housing development can result in a net positive fiscal impact for surrounding areas. ## Opportunity Home Celebrates Nearly 50 Residents Dedicated to Achieving Self-Sufficiency

Opportunity Home San Antonio celebrated 49 residents who completed the Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) program. Participants committed to a five-year contract to achieve personal and professional goals, such as securing employment or purchasing a new home, with resources provided by FSS resident service specialists. Collectively, the graduates increased their earned income by more than \$1.2 million and the total escrow awarded to this cohort amounted to \$493,669. Read more here.
